Deacon Elections will be held on Sunday, August 6.

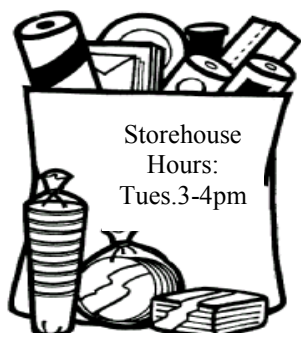
